**Directions:** Use both **text** and **electronic** sources to find the following information:

You need to find the following information for your location:

- **Geography** – What is the land like? What are the major **geographic features** (rivers, mountains, canyons, etc.)?
- **Climate** – What is the weather like? What are the seasons like?
- **People Groups** – Who are the **indigenous** (original) people of the region?

You need to find the following information for a people group (you choose) who live in your location:

- **Food** – What did people eat? Did they hunt? Farm? Fish?
- **Shelter** – What were shelters like? Why were these shelters used?
- **Lifestyle**– Were the people **nomadic** (moving from place to place following resources) or did they live in permanent settlements?
- **Economy**- How did they use the resources they had available?
- **Culture** – What types of artwork did the people create? What sort of religious beliefs did they have?
