

Personal History

Essential Question: How does the history we study relate to my life?

Process: Students will construct a timeline showing personally and historically significant events for each year of their life.

Directions: Using the materials provided for you, research, design and construct a time line of your life. Your time line must include the following:

- One event for each year of your life.
- Dates and 1 sentence explanations for **7 State, National or International events.**
- Dates and 1 sentence explanations for **4 Personally Significant events.**
- Events of your choice for the remaining years.
- Obvious design scheme that clearly presents the type of event, year and organization.

Over the course of this project you will complete a research sheet, rough draft and final draft. Use the table below to keep track of your work. All drafts must be turned in along with your final timeline on the due date.
